

# Elements of the Coat of Arms

## of the Republic of Trinidad & Tobago

The Coat of Arms incorporates important historical and indigenous elements of Trinidad and Tobago.



### The Crest

A fruitful or bearing conventional palm with five branches.

### The Wreath

A rope with six parts using the two colours of the crest or mantle

### The Mantle

Derived from the Queen's mantle. A red cape lined with white ermine (fur)

### The Helm

A helmet from the Royal Coat of Arms adapted to five bars with a red interior

### The Supporters

The Scarlet Ibis and the Cocrico in their natural colours

### The Shield

A gold Steelpan with pan sticks together with two gold hummingbirds

### The Motto

The National Motto written in Times New Roman font
